# CURRICULUM

Play is a child's work. Children gain knowledge about the world through play alone, with others, and in groups. Learning occurs when the environment allows children to role-play, practice social skills, express emotions, and developmental abilities through play.

### Teacher Qualifications

Our lead teachers hold degrees in early childhood education (or closely related degrees) or have at least one year of professional experience in a licensed early childhood center. Staff keep current certifications in CPR and First Aid.

All staff take classes to increase their professional knowledge such as child development, child abuse and neglect with head trauma, prevention and control of infectious diseases, reducing the risk of SIDS and using safe sleep practices, administering medication to children, handling, storing and disposing of hazardous materials and biological contaminants, prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions, building preparedness in child care, emergency preparedness in child care, and Kansas State Licensing regulations.

Staff is also required to attend and maintain at least 16 hours of in-service hours per year in early childhood in pre-approved early childhood education courses.

# NUTRITION & WELLNESS

# HYGIENE

Good hygiene is a fundamental practice of childcare. Taking the time to develop hygiene procedures is a priority at The Tot Spot, Inc.

Illnesses like colds abound at childcare centers, so hygiene helps reduce cross-infection between kids and child care staff. While exposure to illness is always possible, minimizing the risk helps prevent absences of both kids and providers, and keeps sickness from spreading in our program.

With activities like diapering and food preparation going on, hygiene is critical for keeping kids clean and healthy. The Tot Spot, Inc. is dedicated to careful attention to food safety and hygienic toileting procedures to prevent foodborne illness and contamination from germs.

Responsible hygiene also teaches kids good habits that they will benefit from for life. Oral hygiene, for instance, sets kids up to have good oral health into adulthood. We also teach proper hand washing techniques. Habits like these help kids start to practice self-care, which teaches them to nurture themselves and builds their self-esteem.

Annual Enrollment Fee: \$40 for one child or \$60 per family – holds your child's spot for up to 2 weeks. We are unable to hold spots longer than 2 weeks unless enrolling as an infant. Infant Enrollment Fee if holding spot longer than 2 weeks: \$100 per infant. Open enrollment for August – we can hold spots for August enrollment starting in January. \*All Enrollment Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. \*Annual enrollment fees will be due every August 1st.
